
Man-made metal in ark formation

Test results from Galbraith Labs, Knoxville Tennessee, provide evidence of man-made metal in the Noah's ark formation in Eastern Turkey. The site is known as Noah's Ark National Park and is complete with a visitors' center that was built by the Turkish Government, and is located across the valley from Mt. Ararat.



Above is the lab test report that reveals man-made metal in the ark, including aluminum metal that was discovered in the 1800's by modern man. The Bible tells us that Tubal-Cain was an instructor of metal workers (Genesis 4), so they were more advanced in this area than originally thought.



Shown at left in situ, is the end of the 1.5" diameter metal rod which is flared out, apparently struck in the center while still hot. Originally a washer may have been underneath. The location when discovered was on the starboard, outside of the formation about midway. The round shape was a first indicator of something unique, then the metal detector confirmed our suspicions.

The unique, high-tech metals at the site prove the boat shaped formation is man-made using advanced metal working techniques.

Previously, Ron Wyatt had received similar test results on metal retrieved from the site, so this is confirmation of his findings.
